

第 三 問 次の英文は中学校の英語の授業でグループディスカッション(討論)を行っている場面の一コマです。この英文を読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

Mr. Mori: OK, let's talk about "Do junior high school and high school students need to have parental control over their smartphones?" Why don't you start, Sho?

Sho: Well, it's a little difficult question, but I think we need it. My parents have parental control over my smartphone, and I feel safe.

Miku: I don't like the idea that my parents control how I use my smartphone.

Chie: My parents are paying for the bill, so I have to follow their rules. They said they were going to take off the parental control when I become 18 years old. I didn't like the idea at first, but now I feel the same way as Sho.

Kazu: I don't need it. I just don't visit unsafe websites. I have been careful.

Sho: You are lucky that you haven't been in trouble, Kazu. We sometimes visit them without knowing that they are unsafe nones. That's one of the reasons for some of the trouble.

Miku: I think those students have to be more careful. Also, I'm worried about my privacy.

Kazu: I agree with Miku. They were not careful enough. And I won't feel good if my parents check the websites that I visited.

Sho: There are (②異なる) levels of parental control. So, you can keep your privacy.

Miku: How can we learn which websites are not safe if our parents keep protecting us?

Chie: That's a good point. Miku, what will you do if you have to pay a lot of money because you saw some pictures or videos on a website?

Miku: I'll be scared. So I will probably tell my parents about it.

Chie: If you have parental control, that kind of thing won't happen. Of course, we have to learn how to tell safe from unsafe websites. We can do that while we are protected by our parents.

Kazu: That's true. I remember a story about a (3) (liked / student / playing / young / a game / who) on his smartphone. He liked it so much that he got game items with money. The teacher asked four students to talk about "Do we have to have parental control over our smartphones or not?" Two students said that they feel (1) by having parental control. The other two students don't think they need to have parental control over their smartphones. They think it's not (2) for young students to tell which websites are unsafe. Also, they are worried about keeping their privacy. After talking about it, students agreed that it's better for them to (3) more about how to use smartphones wisely.

Have you ever heard of the Japanese person Daisuke Inoue? No one knew Daisuke Inoue until his name was in a famous magazine as one of the most influential Asian people in the 20th century. Well then, what made him so influential?

Daisuke Inoue is the inventor of *karaoke*. People all around the world know what *karaoke* is. Many of us have probably tried *karaoke* before.

Well, unfortunately, he didn't apply for a patent for his invention. A patent is the legal right. If you apply for it, you can make or sell an invention for a particular number of years. If your invention is a success like *karaoke*, you will become rich from your invention.

Let's see how Inoue invented *karaoke*. Daisuke was born in Osaka in 1940. He liked music, so he played in a band when he was young. The band often played music for businesspeople who wanted to sing along to the music with a microphone. One day, one of the businesspeople asked Inoue to come with him on a trip. The businessperson wanted Inoue to play music for him to sing along to. Inoue's band was going to play that night, so he couldn't go with the businessperson. Inoue recorded only music without singing for the businessperson.

3 He thought that the businessperson could (recorded / sing / the music / and / he / play) along. Karaoke was born like this. He said that he didn't do anything special or anything new to make the machine. He just used existing things. Inventions are usually made in this way.

After one of the greatest inventions in history, Inoue has invented other things and applied for patents this time. He enjoys his life even though he didn't become (④) and famous from inventing *karaoke*. Daisuke Inoue is a really great person who doesn't worry much about making money. He is a person who brings joy to many people. I think we need more people like him. If we have more people like him, we can have more fun in our life.
