Thanks to electricity, we can use various machines in our daily lives. As you know, there are many ways to make electricity, such as solar power, wind power, and wave power. People say these ways are sustainable. On the other hand, Japan depends on thermal power generation and burns fossil fuels to create more than 70% of its electricity. It costs a lot of money to buy fossil fuels, and it may be hard to get enough fossil fuels in the future.

ア The Japanese government has also been working hard to promote the use of solar panels since the 1990s. The government first created a subsidy program for the purchase of solar panels for houses in 1994. Now, we often see houses with solar panels on their roofs. There is also a new type of solar power generation called mega solar. Many larger solar panels are put on a large area of land to make a lot of electricity.

You may think that solar power generation has only good points. However, there are many problems. イ First, there is a problem of cost. It costs about one million yen to put panels on the roof of your house. Solar panels may break down in about 20 years. Some people say that it costs about 200,000 yen to throw away solar panels. Second, solar power generation depends on weather conditions. If the weather is bad, we won't be able to create enough electricity. Moreover, ウ(1 know / 2 the mega solar panels / 3 you / 4 do / 5 are / 6 where / 7 put)? People often cut down trees in the mountains to make a large space for the mega solar panels. What will happen ( エ ) it rains heavily in such a place? A landslide may happen. This means that putting up mega solar panels will cause environmental problems.
